Preparation for the Home Stretch

Coming down the home stretch requires preparation for endurance. What are you doing for the stretch run?

We all should be trying to curtail, halt, or reverse our spiritual, physical and intellectual decline, demise, or erosion. In order to be successful at this, our spiritual perception and discernment must be heightened or elevated. To accomplish this, the eagerness and capacity to learn must not decrease.

We must do some damage control to our lives by constantly challenging ourselves to:

1. Become students of the Bible. "Study to shew thyself approved of God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15).
2. Become prayer intercessors. "...and pray one for another, that ye may be healed" (James 5:16).
3. Become domestic missionaries. "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven" (Matthew 5:16).
4. Become more disciplined or regimental. "I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:14).
5. Become finishers. "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith" (II Timothy 4:7).
6. Be zealous and enthusiastic. "And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him" (Colossians 3:17). "Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God" (I Corinthians 10:31).
7. Be more grateful and appreciative. "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (I Thessalonians 5:18). "Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Ephesians 5:20).
8. Consciously exemplify the "Royal Law." "A new commandment

I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another" (John 13:34-35). "This is my commandment, that ye love one another, as I have love you. Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends...These things I command you, that ye love one another" (John 15:12-13, 17).

9. Prioritize and practice "due diligence". "Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall." (II Peter 1:10).

10. Evangelize! "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved" (Jeremiah 8:20). "Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest" (Matthew 9:37-38).
