Mastering Your Time-Part 2

Deuteronomy 28:1 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

2 And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

Obedying the Lord in all good conscience is sowing spiritually in our lifetime! We must remember that with the church sowing occurs in all seasons and not just at a particular time! The opportunity dictates the season!

Galatians 6:10 As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.

Remember, your faith by your works, creates opportunities! The world depends on circumstances for its opportunities, but faith transforms our circumstances into opportunities!

Psalms 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

This says that the tree is already planted, and that planted tree produces fruits continually in his season. Once we are established or planted in the faith, our faith will regularly produce opportunities to be used of God. Thus the little seed planted becomes an established tree that is constantly nourished by its source. The Lord Jesus Christ is that Source!

Psalms 46:4 There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High.

John 4:14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

John 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

Making God our source is being opportunistic! Opportunistic is "taking advantage of opportunities or circumstances especially with little regard for principles or ultimate consequences". Failure is never considered as an option.

All of this occurs in the framework of time! Time is non-negotiable, or retrievable; it is a constant that provides opportunities to be seized upon by faith! All of our initiatives must be planned within the framework of time. Planning starts right now with an attitude adjustment. A plan in hand is a plan in motion!

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Thus, time becomes our greatest resource for accomplishments!
